Yorktown, VA - Oct 15, 2006 On Sunday, October 15, 2006, almost 200 bikers gathered at the Hampton Roads Harley-Davidson store in Yorktown to pay tribute to Vivian Lamb. Vivian was shot to death in August by her husband who then killed himself.

The proceeds from the ride, \$9230 in total, will benefit the programs and services of Transitions Family Violence Services, a Peninsula agency assisting adult and child victims of domestic violence.
