Transitions Family Violence Services hires new Director of Development

HAMPTON, VA—Transitions Family Violence Services recently hired a new full-time Director of Development and Community Relations, Julia Campbell of Boston, Massachusetts. Before coming onboard at Transitions, Campbell worked as Program Development Manager at the *African Presidential Archives and Research Center* at Boston University (APARC). At APARC, Campbell spearheaded fundraising campaigns and coordinated major events and projects, such as the *African Presidential Roundtable* and the *American – African Universities Collaborative*. Campbell served in Senegal, West Africa, in the Peace Corps, as a Community Health Educator.

As Director of Development and Community Relations, Campbell will be responsible for developing and coordinating strategic community education, public relations, and marketing strategies towards the implementation of a Board-approved Development Plan. She will also be tasked with the development of fundraising and endowment fund efforts in conjunction with the Board of Directors Development Committee, as well as the research, identification, cultivation, solicitation and stewardship of potential donors.

Transitions Family Violence Services provides shelter, counseling, advocacy, and support services to victims of domestic violence. Serving Hampton, Newport News, Poquoson and York County, the agency is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization and is fully certified by The United Way of the Virginia Peninsula and the Virginians Against Domestic Violence, a state consortium of domestic violence services.
